1. From 2005 to 2009, Oxford opened a new high school building and fully renovated and expanded our middle and elementary schools.

2. Oxford offers full-day kindergarten for all students, helping them to better prepare for success at an early age.

3. For eight consecutive years, Oxford has achieved Adequate Yearly Progress, which indicates a successful progress toward 100 percent student proficiency.

4. Oxford's PSSA scores annually exceed the state average.

5. From 2002 to 2008 Oxford showed the eighth highest increase in student performance in Pennsylvania.

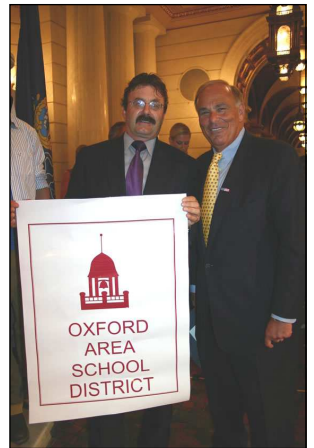
6. Oxford maintains successful partnerships with community organizations including the Jennersville YMCA, Oxford Mainstreet Inc., Oxford Public Library and the Oxford Rotary Club.

7. Oxford has established ongoing partnerships in science education with Ohio State University and Johns Hopkins University.

8. Oxford has robotics teams for grades 2-12 that successfully compete in several area tournaments each year.

9. Since 1994 the Oxford Educational Foundation has funded learning enrichment activities not included in the district budget.

10. Members of the Class of 2011 have been accepted to schools like Drexel University, Washington and Jefferson College, Albright College and Elizabethtown College, and distinguished military institutions including the U.S. Air Force Academy and The Citadel.
