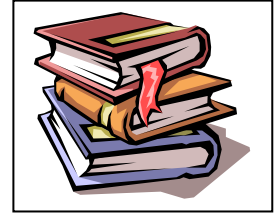


DOCUMENTS AND RECORDS NEEDED FOR SCHOOL REGISTRATION - OXFORD AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT

STUDENT INFORMATION

- Student's Original Birth Certificate or a Certified Copy
- Copy of School Records (if applicable)
- **Current Immunization Record**



PROOF OF RESIDENCY (Evidence of Residency Must Include at least two (2) of the Following):

- Proof of Student's address (settlement papers or lease agreement)
- Current or most recent major utility bill (electric, sewer, gas, telephone or water – only one can be used; another document for proof of residency will be needed)
- Photo I.D. of the parent/guardian registering the student (current Drivers License or state photo identification card; employment I.D. card with home address)
- Pennsylvania Migrant Education Certificate of Eligibility (COE)
- Current local tax bill indicating the address of the taxpayer

PENNSYLVANIA SCHOOL IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

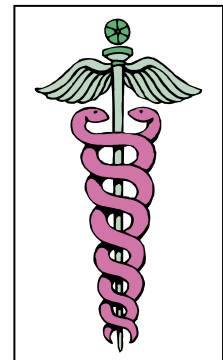
Pennsylvania's school immunization requirements can be found in 28 PA CODE CH. 23 (School Immunization)

Children in ALL GRADES (K-12), who started school before 1997 need the following vaccines:

- 3 doses of tetanus*
- 3 doses of diphtheria*
- 3 doses of polio*
- 2 doses of measles**
- 1 dose of mumps**
- 1 dose of rubella (German measles)**

Children ENTERING SCHOOL (K OR GRADE 1), after 1997 need the following vaccines:

- 4 doses of tetanus* (1 dose on or after the 4th birthday)
- 4 doses of diphtheria* (1 dose on or after the 4th birthday)
- 3 doses of polio
- 2 doses of measles**
- 1 dose of mumps**
- 1 dose of rubella (German measles)**
- 3 doses of hepatitis B
- 2 doses of varicella (chickenpox) vaccine or history of disease



Children ENTERING 7TH GRADE need the following vaccines:

- 3 doses of tetanus*
- 3 doses of diphtheria*
- 3 doses of polio
- 2 doses of measles**
- 1 dose of mumps**
- 1 dose of rubella (German measles)**
- 3 doses of hepatitis B
- Age appropriate dose(s) of varicella (chickenpox) vaccine or history of disease

*Usually given as DTP or DtaP or DT or Td **Usually given as MMR

These requirements allow for medical reasons and religious beliefs. If your child is exempt from immunizations, he/she may be removed from school during an outbreak. Contact your health care provider or 1-877-PA-HEALTH for more information.
